10 New DVD's

1. The sacred echo : hearing God's voice in every area of your life - by Feinberg, Margaret, 1976- - (c2008) DVD 248.4 Fei Sacred Six DVD-based sessions. This DVD-based kit includes a 70-page leader's guide, a sample workbook and one copy of the book *The Sacred Echo*. In each of the session, Feinberg provides Biblical and practical teaching that offers a fresh perspective on our interactions with God through prayer. Each session also includes interviews with people who share their personal times when God seemed silent and when God was at work.

2. You matter more than you think : what a woman needs to know about the difference she makes - by Parrott, Leslie L., 1964- - (c2007) DVD 248.843 Par You Six DVD-based sessions. Each piece of a woman's life represents who you are and what you do. A practical and challenging roadmap to rethink your own self-perceptions and discover who you really are in the eyes of God. Kit includes DVD's; one leader's guide; one workbook (order more if needed) and one copy of hardcover book by same title.

3. The Narrow Path: walking toward peace and nonviolence with John Dear. - by Dear, John - (2007) DVD 261.873 Dea 108 minutes
John Dear, a peace activist who has been arrested over 75 times crisscrosses the country preaching the message of the nonviolent Jesus.

4. Free Market Jesus - by Miller, Donald - (2008) DVD 261.1 Mil ; one 60 minute or two 30 minute sessions
How does the overwhelming commercial messages from advertising shape our view of spirituality, the church and Jesus? Author and speaker Donald Miller illustrates how culture always serves as a lens for our understanding of Christianity and how scripture is still relevant.

5. Have You Heard >From Johannesburg?: Apartheid and the club of the West - by Field, Connie - (2006) DVD 968 Fie 89 minutes
Traces the complex drama of the anti-apartheid movement in the United States, one of South Africa's most important allies. This chronicles a political battle that was also economic, cultural, moral and spiritual.

6. Through the Desert - (2008)

DVD 289.7 Thr 57 minutes

Takes the viewer on an epic journey from the steppes of Uzbekistan to the American midwest, tracing the legacy of 19th century Russian Mennonites who trekked to Central Asia in hopes of fulfilling prophecies.

7. Pax Service: an alternative to war - (2008)

DVD 261.873 Pax 43 minutes.

Between 1951 and 1976 some 1200 young men refused to join the military and instead built homes for WWII refugees, taught farming methods in Africa, helped Greek villages preserve food for the winter, and built a road in the Paraguayan Chaco.

8. Dreaming: a new South Africa - (2006)

DVD 266 Dre 30 minutes

Includes four short vignettes appropriate for use as illustrations, discussion starter, worship clips, Sunday School, small groups and in other setting where conversations about the global church are taking place.

9. Two-Way Mission: North and South Americans in Conversation - (2008)

DVD 266 Two 55 minutes in six video segments.

Documents the creative and joyful movement of God's Spirit in North and South America as mission models expand beyond the classical mission compound to include ministries of presence and partnership. Includes segments about Santa Cruz, Bolivia, the Argentine Chaco and Argentina's Patagonia Region.

10. As We Forgive: can mercy restore what genocide destroyed? - (2008)

DVD 234.5 As 53 minutes.

Two Rwandan women come face to face with the men who slaughtered their families in the 1994 genocide. Explores the lives of four neighbors once caught in opposite tides of a genocidal bloodbath and their journey from death to life through forgiveness
